Pool of Examiners for the Examination for Registration to Practise Medicine (ERPM)

The Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC) seeks the services of an experienced and dynamic Medical or Dental professional/academic who is willing to take up the challenge of running the Examination Unit of the Sri Lanka Medical Council which conducts examinations ERPM and ERPDS. The SLMC invites applications from Medical or Dental practitioners who possess the followings:

Eligibility Criteria for Examiners:

The term of office would be for two years.

At the time of application, the applicant should

- be a board certified specialist in one of the following specialties or a subspecialty that comes under the main specialty:
 - Medicine
 - Surgery
 - Paediatrics
 - Obstetrics and Gynaecology
 - Psychiatry
 - Community Medicine
 - Forensic Medicine
- Possess active registration in the specialist register of the SLMC.
- Be PGIM board certified at least 3 years prior to the date of the application.
- Have past experience as an examiner in the final examination in a State University or the ERPM.
- Have been in active state health service or university service for over three years.
- Be under 75 years in age. This may be extended with written justifiable reasons approved by Council.
- Have been free of any past adverse incidents at medical examinations.

Job Description of Examiners

The examiners would be expected to:

- Fill a declaration form of conflicts of interest at the time of appointment and inform of any such conflicts which may arise during the term of appointment.
- Serve as an examiner of the written and OSCE components of examinations.
- Develop examination Question bank for ERPM Part 1 or ERPM Part 2.
- Be in charge of coordination of a component of the examination.
- Perform essential examination tasks such as participating as an examiner for part II(OSCE) and supervision of the exam

Termination of Appointment:

The appointment would terminate on

- Voluntary resignation due to personal reasons or due to conflicts of interest.
- Reaching 5 years from the date of appointment unless renewed.
- The examiner reaching the age of 75 years unless extended annually with council approval.
- Removal by the Council on having found guilty of adverse performance or behavior as an examiner or due to a conflict of interest.

Remuneration:

Examiners would be paid based on rates approved by the Council for all services provided.

Applicants should submit the full Curriculum Vitae along with a covering letter to highlight his/her suitability for the Pool of Examiners, to reach the following address given below by registered post or by email to head.examination@slmc.gov.lk to receive on or before 25.08.2026.
